

## ICT Lesson Plan 2B

<b>QCA Unit</b>	2B (Creating Pictures)		
<b>Year Group</b>	2	<b>Number in class</b>	
<b>Time for lesson</b>	1hr.	<b>No. of computers</b>	
<b>Preparation</b> Preloaded picture of Elmer template and Elmer template 1 with his checked skin (not coloured in).			
<b>Resources</b> 2Paint , various examples of colourful, bold artwork, the 'Elmer' book			
<b>Learning objectives</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To select colours</li><li>• To select and use the fill tool.</li></ul>			
<b>Technical Vocabulary</b> Fill tool			
<b>Assessment</b> Teacher/LSA observation – that the children <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• selected and used the fill tool successfully</li></ul>			
<b>Introduction ( 10 mins)</b>  <b>Setting the Scene:</b> Show the children some artists work such as Picasso or Matisse and discuss the effects of the bright colours and how they stand out. Show them the cover of 'Elmer' and discuss how he stands out from all the other elephants because of his bright colours. Explain that they are going to create their own painting of Elmer.			

**Main activity ( 40 mins)**

**10 mins** Retrieve the saved picture of Elmer and ask the children how they could make him colourful without having to colour him in using the pen icon. Show the colours. Delete a small area of a line on Elmer and show what happens when the fill tool is used and there is a gap (the colour leaks).

Pupils working independently:

**20 mins** Send the children to their computers and get them to open the preloaded picture of Elmer. Tell them to make a colourful Elmer using the colour and fill icons.

Extension activities

Children could explore the shapes the other icons produce, and design a friend for Elmer using Elmer friend template and Elmer friend template 1.

**10 mins** Show children how to save their work using the 'Save as' command. Demonstrate how to print their work using the 'Print' command. Look at the children's work and discuss merits of them according to brightness.

Assessment cues

Can the child correctly use the 'fill' icon to flood the areas of Elmer the Elephant?

Can children save their work?

Can children print their work?

**Plenary ( 10 mins)**

Share some of the pictures created. Ask the children to compare the effects of each picture i.e. choosing different fill colours. Which do they prefer and why?

Discuss what else the children might draw with the fill tool.
